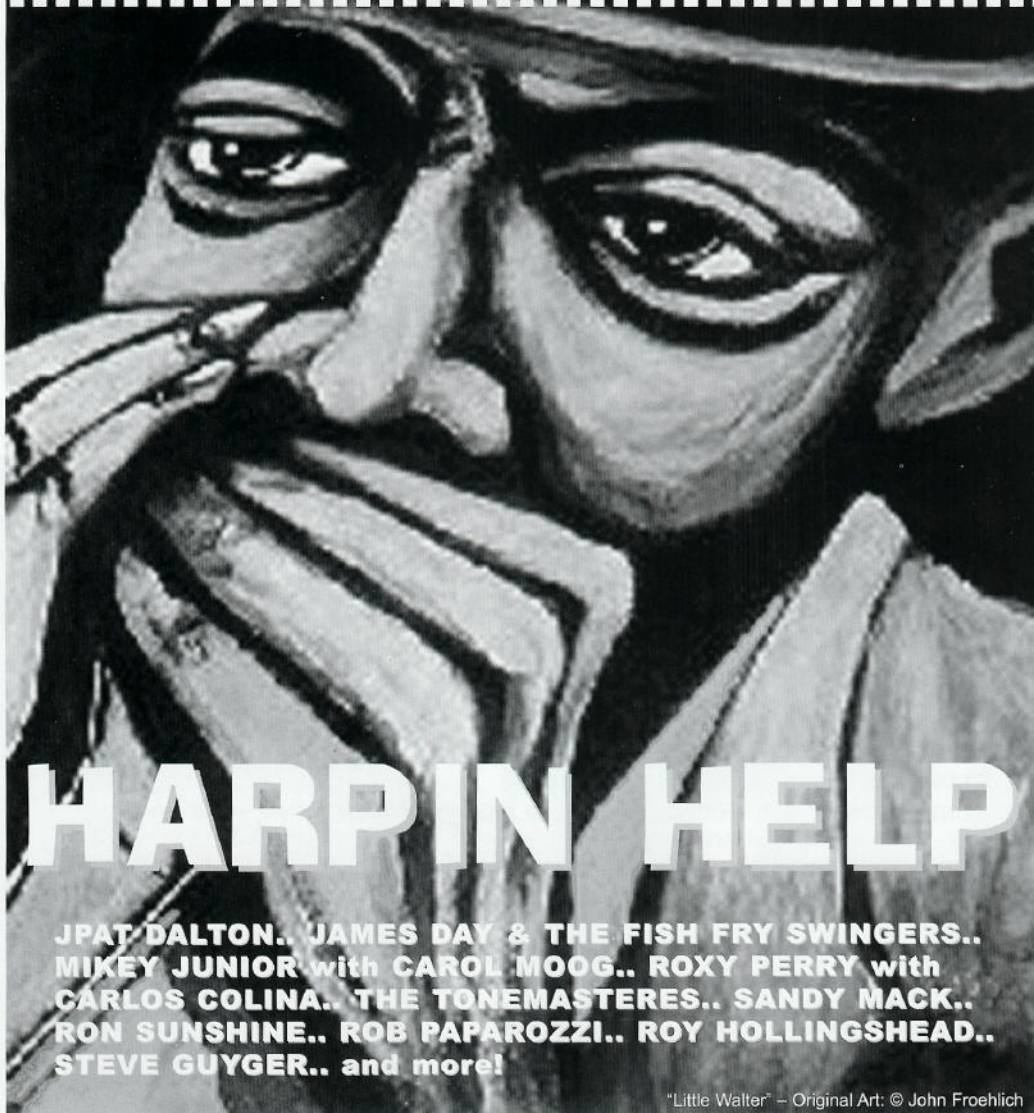

At the not so grizzled age of 22, Mikey Jr. is a harmonica prodigy in the making, fronting his own band distinctly called Mikey Junior and The Stone Cold Blues. The knowledge he holds of traditional blues harp is impressive and his high-end work on the instrument is as clean and as strong as players twice his age. His chief influences are greats such as Sonny Boy Williamson a.k.a "Rice Miller", both Little & Big Walter, Howlin'Wolf, Junior Wells, George "Harmonica" Smith, James Cotton, Snooky Pryor, and all the modern masters of today. Mikey has shared the stage with such blues greats as Carey Bell and his son Lurrie Bell, Steve Guyger, Kenny Neal, Lonnie Shields, Richard Ray Farrell, Linsey Alexander, and Bernard Allison. He may be new on the block, but the old masters are smiling down on this Child of the Blues.
